WRITE A NEW CHAPTER

Aim for around 5,000 words if you're the main author. If you're writing as a co-author, then 2,000 to 3,000 words is great, depending on the requirements of the organizing author.




REVISE A PREVIOUS ARTICLE

This can be the easiest way to write your chapter. Find an article you've written and revise it so it contains valuable, fresh content.

TRANSCRIBE A PREVIOUS VIDEO OR AUDIO

Use a service like Rev.com to transcribe a previously recorded video or audio into written text. Clean it up, and you're ready to go.





RECORD NEW VIDEO OR AUDIO

Record a short workshop to not only transcribe into your chapter, but also repurpose into many media assets to use across the web.



HIRE A GHOSTWRITER

We usually think of hiring a ghostwriter to write an entire book, but there's no reason you can't hire one for a single chapter. There are many online services for writing blog articles, which will work great for this project.
